Submission relating to Public Health and other Legislation (Extension of expiring provisions) amendment bill 2022

I, Miss Kim Lam of [REDACTED]. Request an inquiry and response to the following discrepancies;

- a) You have not provided sufficient evidence, relating to the justification and/or lawful relevance of the bill, to the people of Queensland.
- b) I have not received a detailed update, of the risks and/or consequences of, either a continuation of the proposed bill or the cessation of the bill.
- c) As a result; I am unable to ascertain how the above proposed bill could benefit or prevent any meaningful actions
- d) As per the Federal Registration of Legislation guidelines, which are representative of the Commonwealth of Australia Laws, Acts and Statutes; has not made any provision or proposal, for any current or future mandatory vaccination program, within the borders of the Commonwealth of Australia jurisdiction. This is important and fundamental in relation to the above bill, as the very introduction of the bill, results in the enforcement of mandatory workplace vaccination requirements.
- e) As a result of point (d) the bill may be in contravention of the Federal and Commonwealth laws of right to voluntary vaccination.

Therefore, as Citizen of the Commonwealth of Australia, I hereby declare the above proposed bill, be revoked or withdrawn when the current expiration date of the bill ends on the 30 April 2022.

Noting;

If the bill should be renewed without the explanation and/or settlement of the above discrepancies. You and the responsible members of the Queensland Parliament, may be in breach of the Federal and Commonwealth of Australia laws in relation to right to voluntary vaccination, by encouraging and making allowances for, the enforcement of mandatory workplace vaccination.

This notice of petition has been formulated to inform you, of your duties and responsibilities to the Citizens of the Commonwealth of Australia. If you choose to ignore this notification, you are in acceptance of any resultant legal or lawful actions submitted and pursued, by or on behalf of the Citizens of the Commonwealth of Australia.
