We own and live on 8 acres of land at Devereux Creek, which is Zoned Rural Residential in the Mackay Regional Council area.

As we are retired and are on the pension, we are wanting to plan our Estate, so that our land is on 2 Titles, instead of one, therefore making it simpler for inheritance in our Wills.

We Strongly object to the Strategic Planning laws being introduced where land such as ours, in a mountainous area which is unsuitable for agriculture, and already zoned Rural Residential, will prevent us from providing adequately for our family when we are no longer here.

It would also be a lot more costly to distribute our assets after we are deceased, instead of being able to set up our wills now, as we want it.

Would you PLEASE put this to the Parliament before the hearing, and hopefully have some ammendment made.
