I am a Together member working for the Education department and would like to make a personal submission in regard to the Public Service and other legislation amendment Bill 2020. My issues in light of my personal experience in the non-teaching sector of Queensland Education is the evident lack of human resources review in line with services and growth within each office supporting the teacher sector. I expect that this is similar across all departments in relation to the services offered.

To that end I would like it noted:

- Legislation is a preferable tool for regulating public service employment
- Often Departments do not issue or enforce Directives
- Directives are too easy to alter and the process leading to alterations do not appear as transparent as they should be
- Directives can be changed without a public vote and are less accountable.
