### Submitter Comments:

I am here to state that I object to the proposed changes to homeschooling in Queensland. My two children ages 8 and 10, both with disabilities have been left behind in a system that cannot cope with their needs. My son specifically needs 1 on 1 care which is not able to be funded. He is 2e (highly advanced with mathematics) and highly intelligent but he is unable to stay at school without ongoing assistance. We have tried Occupational Therapist, Pshycologist, peadatrician advise with multiple medications, Behaviour Specialist and assistance feom many external sources such as Autism Hub, Autism Qld and various advocates. Schooling should not require a parent to cease work to ensure their child has a fair and equal education to all other students. Why does our system exclude when they should be capable of providing what should be a fair and equal right to education? I homeschool mg children so I can cater to their disability and educational needs. I homeschool because there is gap between special school and mainstream school. I home school because mainstream looks at my children as a burden because the funding isn't adequate for their needs.
