please consider the removal of amendments to the home education registration including the approved programs adhering to the Qld ed curriculum. After 6 years of Home Educating, my daughters thrive academically and socially. Previously we tried the private and public school system which failed to deliver the quality education they deserve. Home education is a tough slog; one low-income family- we lack any education funding, there is a sharp disparity in spending policy for home education vs school kids, and there are zero educative materials supplied by the government, thus diminishing our children's basic human right to an education (Section 36 of the Human Rights Act 2019 & Section 36 Education (General Provisions) Act 2006), The wording 'appropriate to the child's needs' in addition to s15 of the Act specifying that all rights are intended to be enjoyed by all people without discrimination. This proposed amendment of the bill will just make life so much more complicated, inturn cost of living for me will be higher, and my children won't have the quality of education they have now, which is currently personally designed to produce quality active members of society.
