Dear committee.

My name is Jodie Tupper, I hereby object to the proposals in the education bill 2024.

I have been home educating for the past 3 years after a number of concerning issues have arisen under government funding insulations.

. My child was severely bitten by another child without qualified staff noticing.

. My child was bullied in the playground and pushed off the swing equipment resulting in loss of teeth.

. My child was bullied by both the teachers and the children because she is Caucasian to the point that she wanted to change her colour of her skin. Without having the opportunity to home education I feel my child would have been in significant harm. We are dedicated to providing a high quality education and my child is developing beautifully with being home educated.

Furthermore the education community has become aware of the report into child deaths released by the QFCC. We are very concerned that a series of tragic cases are being linked to home education where there appears to be only one home schooled child in the matters reviewed and where it is clearly a department of child safety issue. We are devastated to learn of this death but have no confidence that the proposed changes to the laws will save any child at risk of significant harm. The conflation of these issues also harms loving and dedicated home educating families who provide high quality education to beautifully developing children and young people.
