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Submitter Comments:

All of my 4 children have been through the public system and the curriculum was NOT reflective of our views, knowledge or values. Our opinion of the curriculum was that it was often more reflective of political movements and agendas, has little practical real-life preparatory content, and evolves in a way that clearly followed the influence of politics and mainstream coercive reporting and corporate influencing. Parents should be able to choose a curriculum that works for their child and reflects their values and interests. The current registration and reporting system for home-schooling is working well, there is no need to change it. Instead of trying to take control of home-schooling families and content, I really feel the Government should review the school system and curriculum, and investigate the reasons that so many families are withdrawing their children from it. If this was not our final year in the school system, we would have withdrawn our children from the system too a few years ago.
