Dear Hon Mark Bailey MP My role at present is Group RI Coordinator of 6 schools. My understanding is that the Education, Employment, Training and Skills Committee is currently reviewing proposed changes to the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 and one of these proposed changes has as its aim to support and protect students by: "facilitating proactive and proportionate sharing of information when a student transfers between Queensland schools". It is my understanding that all personal information is transferrable between state schools but student's Religious Instruction (RI) consent is excluded and is not transferred between schools. I feel that it would be more efficient for schools, parents & the students if this consent was transferred as well.
