She was so anxious about keeping up academically and that her head was cloudy and she couldn't take any information in, therefore fell further and further behind. (Adding to the anxiety and creating a vicious cycle!)

Lets not forget that kids can start prep at anywhere from age 4.5 years to 6.5 years old but are expected to be at the same academic level! Say What?!

Everyday I told myself there has to be another way, turns out that way was homeschooling. I made the decision to put our families mental health and wellbeing first and have not looked back.

Since we started homeschooling our lives have changed dramatically.

Our children are thriving, they are smart and confident and have grown to love learning in their OWN way.

Our home is calm and there is always plenty of learning projects on the go.

They are well mannered, free thinking, show common sense and have grand imaginations, we often get the comment 'oh you must be homeschooled' because of this.

Forcing our children into a box where they must learn the national curriculum would be a massive disservice to them and to future generations.
