To the Education, Employment, Training and Skills Committee,

I am writing to object to the Education (General Provisions) and Other Legislation Bill 2024 in the current form. I have specific concerns with the implications of Clauses 18, 64 & 68 and I am in support of the Free2homeschool Movement.

I felt like I was actually learning what I was doing when I was home with my mum as a little girl and I would enjoy learning. When I went to school it hindered my ability to learn in a safe environment whilst I was there, I felt sick everyday and had frequent stress/anxiety headaches; and I was bullied/harassed/teased and made to feel like an outcast. It was not a welcoming environment at school, and I much more preferred learning CLE at home with my mum where I felt safe, satisfied with the pace I was learning at and a warm space and the kind patience of my mum helped. Quite frankly I learnt nothing whilst in 3 different schools and felt hated and disliked by my peers.
