Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to express my concerns about the proposed legislative changes for education.

Clause 60 of the proposed changes completely removes access to Provisional Registration for 60 days. This means that if a family fails to secure an enrolment and needs to leave school for any reason it will deny the family access to any Provisional Registration option, which would cover them for time including waiting for next term.

Under the proposed changes, they would either have to apply to home educate and provide a full years educational plan or request an Exemption from the Chief Executive.

This does NOT help the SAFETY of our children, this is removing options which support them currently based on no evidence.
