Page 15, para 7, line 1	I am advised that Tony Keyes performed in his position as <del>Parliamentary Counsel</del> Senior Deputy Crown Solicitor under the Newman Government	Minor correction of fact
Page 19, para 1, line 2	We have had 1,350 beds since 2015, and we have another <del>859</del> 869 in current projections.	Minor correction of fact
Page 19, para 4, line 3	... will deliver around 404 beds; and a new Toowoomba Hospital, with \$1.3 billion to deliver <del>119</del> 118 additional beds.	Minor correction of fact
Page 40, para 11, line 1	So far the funding has gone towards \$3 <del>\$4</del> million for capital works and community projects that enhance the recognition of our veterans	Minor correction of fact
Page 41, para 9, line 8	Of course, we are offering free TAFE for Queenslanders under the age of <del>26</del> 25, from memory, to ensure that they get the best start in life with training through TAFE	Minor correction of fact
Page 48, para 10, line 5	While construction was impacted by the flood event, I understand that the theatre is <del>still on track to open next year</del> expected to be open mid-2024.	Minor correction of fact
