My name is Natascha Seben, and I wish to oppose the bill to extend emergency powers in Qld until 2022. It is simply not true that we are in any state of emergency, in fact, the current lockdowns and measures in place are doing more harm to the population of Australia then Covid. We have had 1 person die Australia wide from Covid in the 2021 year to date, That is NOT an emergency. It would also be false to assume that this is due to the 'Covid' efforts enforced by our government. Viruses can NOT be stopped by governments. Face masks are a false sense of security as are lock downs. It is estimated that over 80% of people are asymptomatic to SARS - COV2 due to previous exposures to corona viruses over their lifetime.
