To Whom It may concern,

I am writing to voice my strong opposition to the extension of emergency powers in Queensland.

I fear faith in government and democracy is severely diminishing under severe government overreach and mismanagement.

As new info has emerged this government has not changed course, and doubles down on ineffective and highly damaging measures under these emergency powers. They do not provide evidence for their measures. There is serious questioning on PCR testing and its cycle use, false positives and therefore true covid death numbers.

There is no evidence on the effectiveness of masks and plenty on the harm caused by bacterial infection, low oxygen and safety concerns with concealed identification.

Police are being used to instill tyrannical rules on free and innocent people leading to psychological harm on both sides.

Small businesses are being decimated.

Our privacy under the federal privacy act is being dismissed by the forced collection of data to obtain essential items such as food.
