476 Governor-General may extend a human biosecurity emergency period

- (1) The Governor-General may vary a human biosecurity emergency declaration to extend the human biosecurity emergency period for a period of up to 3 months if the Health Minister is satisfied that:
- (a) the declaration listed human disease is continuing to pose a severe and immediate threat, or is continuing

to cause harm, to human health on a nationally significant scale; and

- (b) the extension is necessary to prevent or control:
- (i) the entry of the declaration listed human disease into Australian territory or a part of Australian territory; or Authorised Version

How is it that the commonwealth can only extend an emergency period by 3 months yet the Qld Govt. can go beyond that?

What is not granted to the State by the Australian Constitution, (Biosecurity Act 2015) has no force in law.

This proposed Bill is unlawful as it exceeds the powers of the BioSecurity Act which has been crafted to avoid abuses of power as proposed by this Bill.
