Subject: Extension of the Public Health Emergency

Dear Sir/Madam,

It is very concerning to hear of this extension bill being presented to the Qld Parliament recently.

It is now the Qld Government causing stress and hardship to the Queensland public and businesses through its harsh draconian lockdowns and restrictions, not the virus.

80% of people who contract the virus are asymptomatic or have mild symptoms. The Queensland Government has also denied access to a safe and effective treatment (Hydroxychloroquine) by introducing legislation last year to make it illegal for doctors to prescribe it. This action alone suggests the Qld Government is not interested in people being safe and having access to all available treatments but more interested in creating fear and imposing harsh restrictions on Queenslanders.
