The Public Health and Other Legislation (Further Extension of Expiring Provisions) Amendment Bill 2021 extends a range of emergency measures, including the extraordinary powers of the Chief Health Officer, Dr Jeannette Young.

These powers include the ability to impose restrictions on the free movement of citizens, their ability to travel, conduct a business, attend school, church or sport, as well as the power to issue mandates on mask wearing, social distancing rules, the numbers of persons who can gather at any one time, border closures, area lockdowns and quarantine mandates.

I also believe that this was put through without the general public, who voted for this government to uphold our rights as citizens of Qld. We have lost our rights, rights that are law which is the basis or our country and state, and are being overruled by a government who were supposed to be working for the people. Families unable to see loved ones, the right to travel as needed or desired in our state and country, our every movement being tracked and controlled by the powers that be. It takes years to know some of these facts, I have young adults as children and there is no way I want them putting themselves in the situation where they might be the small number of people affected by blood clots. My parents who are frail apparently have less chance if being affected or is it just that they are elderly and not valued enough and if something happens it's only a small percentage of the overall number. We are not statistics. We are people who have lost our rights to choose. Vaccinated people will soon not have to quarantine ECT.
