

Public Health and Other Legislation (Further Extension of Expiring Provisions) Amendment

To whom it may concern,

I have an objection to the further extension of expiring provisions.

The QLD government has greatly restricted our rights for over 18 months with social distancing, facemasks, tracing apps, lockdowns, hand washing, sanitising and many other measures you claim necessary. None of these have any valid evidence to prove a positive outcome to the claimed emergency situation.

The result of the PCR test doesn't give any proof of viral infection since it is not designed to determine the cause of symptoms. Because of this, using the number of positive PCR test results to claim the situation as an emergency is illogical.
