Dear member of parliament

I am writing this in protest to the proposed amendment bill for the Further Extension of Expiring Provisions, as well as the general roll-out of all COVID-19 vaccines.

The death toll from COVID-19 is around 2% (less, considering the inclusion of cases with already marginalised immune systems), whereas in the short period that COVID-19 vaccines have been available more than 25,000 people have died, according to the CDC. Additionally, numerous malevolent side-effects have been reported from the mRNA vaccines including vaginal bleeding and miscarriages. We have yet to see what the long term effects may be.

As a young woman who has not yet had a family, and hope to become a mother someday, these reports concern me as well as many of my friends. It is in the interest of the Australian public that COVID-19 vaccines not be rolled out until further testing has been done. There has been research done into safe and effective cures to the virus that do not involve spike-protein production and its reported side-effects.

I hope that the Australian Government will consider the health of future Australians, especially the younger generations, and therefore STOP the imminent and widespread rollout of these vaccines.
