Subject: Plea AGAINST extension of emergency powers

Dear Committee Members,

I do not consent to the extension of emergency powers to 30 April 2022 as proposed by the Public Health and Other Legislation (Further Extension of Expiring Provisions) Amendment Bill 2021.

In the interest of the freedoms of Australian people and the maintenance of our constitutional rights, I object to this amendment.

It violates the nature of Democracy and ignores the validity of available information which questions the impact of Covid 19 and its relation to populations' vulnerability (especially in comparison to other SARS variants).
