In our initial feedback to Department of Education, Training and Employment we recommended the following: Provision for parents to report to the school any indiscipline that is taking place whether it is students, teachers or general community who have access to school.

Further to the above feedback we like to make the following comments:

We believe schools should be provided support through additional resources such as comprehensive relationship building programs, bullying awareness programs, bullying management plans and additional staffing. P&Cs Qld wishes for a collaborative process with a more empowered principal, to set the school behaviour management policy within the Department's guidelines. We believe the school governance body plays an important role in setting out the school's behaviour management plan.
