

Also, please note a correction required to the record on page 8, where Mr Busby indicated that the Department records all hostile person decisions on the OneSchool database and that all decisions will be recorded on that database.

It has been clarified that not all records of these decisions are recorded on OneSchool. The section 337 (written direction about a person's conduct at the institutions premises for up to 30 days), section 339 (written direction requiring person to immediately leave and not re-enter the premises for 24 hours) directions must be copied by the principal to the regional director. The regional director is responsible for collating those and providing them for the purposes of the annual report. In terms of OneSchool, the principal often will enter a record in the 'parent contact' section of a student's individual profile. It is not proposed at this point to change the procedure to require all records to be kept on OneSchool.
