Re: Fixed Parliamentary Terms
in Queensland

With reference to the above matter I advise as follows.
I support fixed government terms in Queensland,
but strongly recommend three (3) year periods as
distinct from four (4) year periods.

houses for State Governments and therefore Queensland
has that aspect correct.
