**Re: South East Queensland Water (Restructuring) and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2012
Submission regarding the proposed amendments to the Queensland 'Water Fluoridation Act 2008'**

In view of the available information and related scientific references, I respectfully submit and request that the Queensland Government uphold the principles of our democracy by not forcing Water Fluoridation on the people of Queensland, in particular, Bundaberg Regional Council areas by amending the 'Water Fluoridation Act 2008', with the inclusion of a clause or section which provides individual communities, particularly Bundaberg to be exempt.

It is requested that an amendment be made to Clause 80 so that the new subsection 6A raise the exemption level from the proposed 10,000 to 60,000 population.

It is also requested that Bundaberg Regional Council be acknowledged for exception into Section 8.

I request that the Queensland Government re-consider the forced fluoridation and that in relation to Bundaberg particularly, the 'Water Fluoridation Act 2008' be amended to include an 'exclusion clause' or section which provides the Bundaberg community the opportunity to exit the requirements of the said Act.
