* The percent of government employers with a statutory or common law claim is higher due to the fact that these employers are typically larger organisations and therefore their exposure is higher. This is evident by the claim rate being smaller for government organisations than for non-government employers.

- 3) Declared wages are based on the 2010/11 year due to a lag in reporting.
