I write to make a submission on the Industrial Relations (Restoring Fairness) and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2015.

I urge the committee to recommend passage of this bill without delay to ensure that the rights of public servants and local government workers are restored to them.

The Newman LNP government elected in 2012 removed protections for job security as well as many other basic rights by amendments to legislation without consultation.

The right to organise collectively to achieve better working rights and conditions is a basic human right. The Newman government undemocratically curtailed this right.

Furthermore, I urge the Committee to consider the legislation pertaining to High-Income Senior Employees (Chapter 6A - IR Act) and make a recommendation to repeal this legislation.
