We therefore take the opportunity to make one point only. It relates to the following:

- ✍ require State government departments and statutory bodies, in their annual reports under the *Financial Accountability Act 2009*, to report on their progress in developing policies and programs, and delivering services, that are consistent with the strategic direction of the government response to the Queensland Plan;

The University would be very concerned about the reporting burden associated with this measure were it meant to include Universities. The University of Queensland has an annual budget of approximately \$1.7B. In the order of 3% of our revenue flows from the Qld Government, the remaining part from other sources, mostly the Commonwealth and students.
