Re: Brisbane Olympic and Paralympic Games Arrangements Amendment Bill 2024

Given the extremely short timeframe in which submissions could be made, CRA has not had the opportunity to consider the Brisbane Olympic and Paralympic Games Arrangements Amendment Bill 2024 (the Bill) in detail. - 1. The Bill should contain a focus on the legacies that regional areas, such as the Sunshine Coast, will experience

There is an opportunity to deliver legacies that will not only support the short-term outcomes for a successful Olympics and Paralympics but also have long-term improved outcomes for other current problems associated with a rapidly increasing population on the Sunshine Coast. These problems include the need for vastly improved:

 north and south areas of the Sunshine Coast but also the east-west linkages. These networks
 need to cater for easy, safe access to all the planned upgraded sporting facilities, for example the
 mountain biking facilities at Parklands.
