To whom it may concern

We are writing to urge you to vote down the Termination of Pregnancy Bill 2018.

The laws of Australia currently protect all people regardless of sex, ability, where they live, age or size. For example, a toddler can't protect himself with strength or voice but we would surely protect him from anyone wishing to harm or kill him. That protection includes those situations where the child needs protection from his own mother who is unable to care for him properly. If a mother is unable or unwilling to protect and care for a baby, the state steps in and takes him from her, for that baby's protection. That baby's life is precious.
