Dear Committee,

In regard to the above Bill, as a proud Queenslander I wish to register my opposition to this Bill. I object on the following grounds

1. Particularly the provision for babies to be aborted over the 22 week period. I believe this to be akin to murder. In the last month we had a criminal case in Queensland where the offender was convicted on 2 counts of murder, one for the murder of the woman and one for her unborn child. Now the Government wants to give legal sanction to this. Unbelievable ! I have spoken to many people about this bill recently and have yet to come across any person who is in favour of this state sanctioned murder of our young defenceless children just prior to birth.
2. It seems there are no clauses in this bill which take the rights of the unborn into account. It seems to be all about social reasons for the mother . Again Unbelievable.
3. The requirement to get two doctors to sign off on the proposed abortion is very flimsy indeed and offers no protection to the child .

There are lots more I could add to this submission but as a courtesy to the committee I have kept it as brief as possible. I just ask that the committee take their responsibility to protect unborn Queenslanders seriously,
