

Reasons

Decriminalisation of abortion would make it legal up to the moment of birth. Allowing abortion right up to birth has nothing to do with women's health or women's rights. But it completely tramples on the rights of the unborn child.

-Women's rights argument in favour of abor ion: "women have a right to decide what to do with their bodies" <u>The true:</u> <u>A baby is not part of a</u> woman's body it has a unique genetic code and sometimes a different blood type than the mother.



- Severe psychological effects on the moher (even father and family) including depression. Even higher if they see the baby/remains after an abortion.

-Less han 3% of abortions were because the child had a disability and less than 1% were because of rape

- A baby in the womb has every hing it needs except for food and shelter. Is it then ok to "abort" homeless people or those who go hungry? This shouldn't define a person's right to life.

- The current law allows for Doctors and nurses to refuse being part of an abortion. Where are the rights of them if they are made to par icipate or refer for one?
