

Submission re the Queensland Termination of Pregnancy Bill 2018.

To whom it may concern

I would like to make a submission and refer to the Queensland Termination of Pregnancy Bill 2018.

This bill is about Abortion for any reason until birth.

Abortion is not recorded in death statistics nor is the reason for termination of life.

Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) reveals that the main single cause of death is Coronary Heart Disease at about 19,000 in 2016 and this is mainly in the elderly. All deaths in 2016 was 158,504. Infant deaths was 970.

Aborted babies is about 75,000 to 100,000 per year and will rise after this bill.

Abortion is not a health issue but a death issue and it is a "national tragedy".

There is no such thing as a good abortion.
