## **RE: Termination of Pregnancy Bill 2018**

As well as failing to consider the rights of an unborn human, this bill fails to address the rights of one of the two consenting partners, the father of the child, as well as the rights of medical practitioners with a conscientious objection.

The bill fails to address the need to educate or inform the mother of the child of their options.

With such a bill in place, who will speak out on behalf of our most precious members of society? Who will have the right?

These babies, although unborn, have functioning hearts and brains, and thus need our protection.
