A 2000 study cited by *Hush* and prepared by Dr. Brenda Major, a Professor of Psychology & Communications at the University of California, recorded that approximately 21% of American women who receive an abortion believed that their abortion did more harm than good. This percentage grew to 28% within two years of the abortion.

Reference the YouGov Galaxy Poll from August 2018 1000 people canvassed.

- 62% agree unborn at 23 weeks is a person with rights.
- 75% agree abortion harms women's health.
- 26\$ personally know someone pressured to have an abortion.
- 60% oppose mid-term abortions past 13 weeks.
- 76% oppose late term abortions past 23 weeks.
- 88% agree independent counselling.
- 85% support informed consent.
- 79% support cooling-off period.
- 74% support conscientious objection.
