

At what stage of development does the Queensland Parliament Health Committee decide a foetus has human rights?

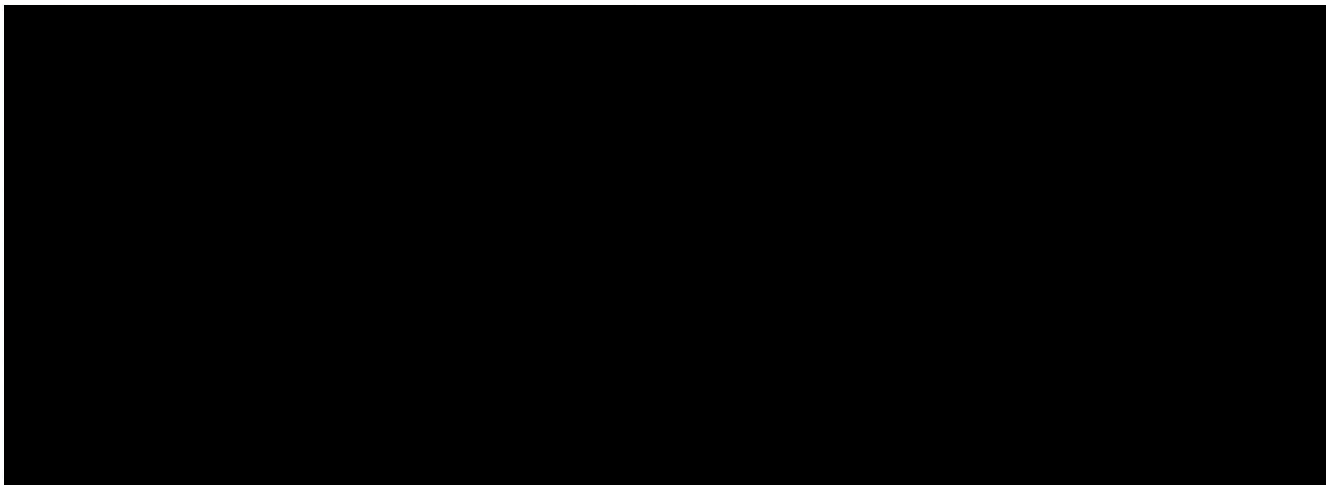
You're considering whether an abortion can be undertaken at 22 weeks gestation.
