I Lita Stacey of the above address strongly oppose the Termination of Pregnancy Bill 2018 for the following reasons:

1. The Bill effectively allows abortion to birth which is not the case anywhere else in Australia;

3. It contains no safeguards for women considering abortion
4. The Bill ignores community standards, and disregards global trends
5. It promotes abortion as a positive option
6. Allows late term termination of viable babies
7. Does not allow doctors and health workers to act in accordance with their own conscience and refuse to refer a woman for an abortion;
8. Does nothing to assist women to access the best health support or prevent them from being coerced; and
9. Ignores the evidence that women who have abortions suffer later including depression.
