Please accept this feedback from my family and I on the Termination of Pregnancy Bill.

This bill as touted as being for Women's rights and yet permits the legal termination of unborn people apparently without a recommendation from a medical practitioner prior to 22 weeks, and with a recommendation from a medical practitioner after 22 weeks. It would be reasonable to expect if this bill was past some of those unborn terminated would be future women.

Our community is horrified when a horrible event happens to a woman and even more horrified when a horrible event happens to a pregnant mother. This is reflected in the ruling by the courts against those who have committed horrible acts against pregnant mothers. Our community, Queensland, values life and values the life of the unborn. The unborn have a life; they have a spirit, and a growing functioning mind and body, and right to live. Parents are legally required to provide the necessities of life to their children demonstrating our community values children as people who need to be cared for.
