Please ensure that this proposed legislation is not brought into law in this State of Queensland.

There is little I can tell you about the immediate victims involved in an abortion procedure (mother and child) and little you would not already know of how the child is killed in the course of the procedure and the horrific emotional and often physical outcomes for the post-procedure grieving mother.

There is also the crushing emotional and guilt-ridden outcome for the oft-forgotten father of the child. So, unless we have been living in a cave these past several decades, we are all aware of the hideous and sometimes fatal (always fatal for the child!) outcomes for mother, father and child.

However, the main purpose of my letter to you is to warn you of the even more chilling and inescapable consequence for those who would promote, encourage, enable, or, God forbid, carry out this murderous and inhuman act.
