- Currently accountability for prescription services can be enforced via the professional standards expected of the pharmacist as an owner if this is a corporate as it is in America they pay fines at a corporate level but there is no individual accountability, in Australia if the owning pharmacist does not act in the best interest of the customer there can be significant ramifications for them maintaining their professional registration & therefore business
- Competition in the retail space supermarkets in Australia are dominated by 2 players there is a risk to the numbers of owners if corporate ownership is allowed
