Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing as a pharmacy owner concerned about the inquiry into pharmacy.

I have operated smaller professional service community pharmacies around the Brisbane area for 30 years. My current pharmacy is here in Wishart/Upper Mt Gravatt, Brisbane, in a small shopping village, located near a number of medical centres. I look after two nursing homes and provide a forward dispensing model aiding a professional interaction with patients.

I support the government setting up a pharmacy council, to manage local pharmacy issues and bring us in line with the other states, but I'm really concerned about the potential deregulation of pharmacy ownership laws.

I believe that any deregulation of current laws of ownership threatens the existence of independent, community-based pharmacies in Queensland like my own. I believe the services that I deliver to my community would not be provided under a corporate model, which would lead to worse outcomes for patients in my area of Mt Gravatt.

With regards to questions concerning the scope of pharmacists, I would support any extension of scope which allows me to provide the services my community needs. Delivering flu vaccinations through pharmacies is an excellent example of how pharmacists can improve the accessibility of important health services.

We participated in the national Diabetes Screening trial last year, have implemented for the first time our influenza vaccination program, and have for a number of years screened for Blood Pressure, Cholesterol and Blood Glucose as an adjunct service. I employ a Child Health Nurse who also runs our Enuresis Clinic and she has just had her ONE THOUSANDTH child go through her care.

Pharmacies play an essential role in the health system as primary health providers. While providing PBS medicines is the core of our business, I am also proud to provide quality advice, assistance, triage and care to members of my community. Ensuring the health of my customers is part of my role as a health professional and I am concerned that a move to deregulate community pharmacy would undermine the model which serves communities like my own so well.
