I would like to make a submission opposing the proposed Bill on Abortion Law Reform.

This Bill seeks to allow abortion up until birth which is a very barbaric and retrograde step. This would legalise piecemeal dismemberment of near term foetuses causing immeasurable pain and suffering. Studies have shown that the foetus can feel pain from as early as 20weeks - doctorsonfetalpain.com - imagine the amount of pain when limbs are being torn off during an abortion of a late term foetus.
