My wife and I are strongly opposed to this proposed amendment bill and hereby make a submission to Parliament.

We believe that human life begins at conception, and that every effort should be given to support a growing human in the womb until birth. We understand there are exceptions which, to us, are adequately covered under present legislation.

This bill, if passed, will give a woman the right to abort a child at any time before birth. Any legislation that allows this "right" to a woman gives no consideration whatsoever to the "right" of a child to life and, in our opinion, is heartless and damaging to society as a whole.
