Babies in Queensland have been aborted and left to die.eg.,27 babies were unsuccessfully aborted and left to die in Queensland last year.

All life is sacred and no baby is unwanted as there are many couples who wish to adopt.

Many babies are aborted due to a disability (which is the equivalent to eugenics) or because they are not the sex of preference.

Killing babies is a destructive act and not a solution to the problem. The Universal Declaration of Human Rights Article 3 declares that "Everyone has the Right to Life".

In Queensland it is an offence to act cruelly towards an animal causing unnecessary pain and suffering. Penalties of 7 years gaol or a fine of \$235,600.00 for a natural person or \$1,178,00.00 for a corporation apply.

This is a disturbing indictment on our society that allows such an unbalanced skew that places more importance on the suffering of an animal than it does to the pain and suffering of a human being viz., a baby which

Suffers dismemberment of limbs first then crushing of the skull to remove it from the mother's womb.

Many women espouse the motto "It's my body and I can do whatever I like with it". This motto does not concur with scientific and medical facts. In fact the mother's body produces hormones to prevent the baby in the uterus being

Aborted since the body regards the baby as a "foreign" body. This scientific and medical reality shows that the baby is NOT the Mother's body but a separate entity with it's own genetic make up.
