<u>Submission to Abortion Reform Committee</u> The following are the reasons for my concern and hence this submission

The proposed Bill tabled by Mr Rob Pyne MP provides allows for the abortion of a child from conception to birth. I oppose this Bill on the grounds as there are no conditions applied to this Bill. No consideration given as to:

- (1) The dignity of the child within the womb
- (2) No provision's given re the health of the child within the womb
