Dear Parliamentary Committee Members

I consider the bill put forward by Rob Pyne to be both unnecessary and dangerous.

- 1. **Unnecessary** because the right to abortion already exists in Queensland where a medical practitioner certifies that the termination of the unborn child is necessary to prevent 'serious danger' to the physical or mental health of the mother and the unborn child is less than 22 weeks gestation. This law goes far enough. Already the life of the child rates behind the mother's physical or mental health.
- 2. Rob Pyne's bill is a **dangerous** threat to the lives of thousands more unborn children who will lose their lives year upon year (if the bill is passed into law) simply because they are <u>unwanted by their mother</u>, regardless of how many weeks gestation.
