Thank you for reviewing the bill introduced by Rob Pyne MP. I appreciate that our current abortion laws should be reviewed and assessed. However, I wish to oppose the bill introduced by Mr Pyne.

Hospitals are able to keep babies alive who are born after 20 weeks gestation, while this bill would allow abortions beyond this gestation period.
