Thank you for the opportunity to review the Public Health (Medicinal Cannabis) Bill 2016.

I have a few comments related to the practical application of the bill into a hospital environment.

- Is it possible to have multiple 'secondary dispensers' within the same pharmacy? This would be required for a hospital pharmacy where it is not feasible to have a single (or only two) people available at all times for dispensing of medicinal cannabis, and coverage during extended hours, weekends and on-call is required.
- What qualifications and prior approval does a 'facilitator' have to have within a hospital? Is it possible to have many, as for a patient in hospital it will be common to have very many nurses involved in their care with responsibility to administer their medication, including medicinal cannabis. Or is that a title conferred to whoever is administering the product to the patient at the time without the need for prior approval? (Note, prior approval per named patient would not be practical).
