Dear Members,

I am writing to urge you not to recommend any change in the current legislation, which is designed to protect unborn children from abortion. I point out to your members what U.S. candidate Hilary Clinton does, that these children are persons. But unlike her, I urge you to maintain their rights as people under the current law and protect them as the current law was designed to do.

I also urge the Committee to remember that the UN respects unborn children as people and protects them under its charter.
