I wish to express my objection to Rob Pyne's Abortion Bill being considered by the Queensland Parliament.

I believe the current legislation in Queensland is sufficient for the protection of the mother should there be life-threatening issues. Mr Pyne's proposed bill would condemn this state to radical abortion laws that do not enhance the concept of the sanctity of life.

1. Pregnancy is the result of male and female interaction. It is not the sole responsibility of the mother to make the decision for the abortion.
