I wish to write to you to inform you of my concern in regards to the new abortion bill being put forward by Cairns MP Rob Pyne.

Mr Pyne has previously tried to put this bill forward and many Queenslanders overwhelmingly rejected removing the current safeguards earlier this year. More than 1,400 wrote to the parliamentary inquiry looking into the first bill and around 24,000 signed a petition against the abortion bill.

It is my request that Mr Pynes bill is once again looked into, as i fear that it will remove safeguards for unborn children and women, it can even affect the male involved in the pregnancy.
